

HOLY WEEK

ur celebration of Palm Sunday begins the most powerful week of the year, Holy Week. It seems like there is never enough time this week to sufficiently grasp the glory of these days and the power of our salvation in Christ.

The drama begins today with the entrance into Jerusalem and the reading of the passion narrative. It is hard to fathom just how quickly things changed from being heralded as the Messiah to being arrested, ridiculed, and condemned.

Our week continues with a Day of Grace at St. Joseph Church on Wednesday, March 27. Confessions and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be available from 9:00am to 9:00pm. It is a great opportunity to take a little bit of time to prepare yourself for Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter. If you are able to spend some time before the Eucharist, maybe consider reading one of the passion narratives from the Gospel and meditating upon it.

On Holy Thursday, we'll have the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00pm at both St. Joseph Church and Immaculate Conception Church. We can relive the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. The Mass ends with a procession of the Eucharist through the Church, ending at an altar of repose. This signifies the journey that Jesus and His disciples took to the Garden of Gethsemane.

Eucharistic Adoration will be available until midnight at St. Joseph and Immaculate Conception. It is a great opportunity to spend some time with our Lord while He was alone in the prison. Jesus spent Thursday night alone in the prison and our time of prayer can accompany Him

in His agony. Also Thursday night, you can participate in the seven churches pilgrimage.

On Good Friday, the celebrations of the Passion of the Lord are at Immaculate Conception and St. Joseph in the afternoon. After each service, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered. At these Liturgies, we venerate the cross of the Lord and pray for the Church and the world.

Our Easter Vigil begins at 9:00pm at Immaculate Conception on Saturday night. This is the most glorious Mass of the year. If you are able, I highly recommend attending. Also, we'll have 12 people come into the Church this year which is awesome!

Finally, our Easter Sunday schedule is a little different from a normal Sunday schedule. We have to add a couple extra Masses to accommodate the crowds. Also, Fr. Jedidiah Tritle is able to help us out for the weekend, so we're grateful to have a little extra help. Here is the schedule:

Good Friday: Fasting & Abstinence Reminders

Fasting refers to eating one full meal in a given day, as well as two small meals that combined do not equal a full meal. Abstinence refers to refraining from eating meat. The USCCB instructs: "Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics...When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal....If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the 'paschal fast' to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection." 

Holy Thursday Pilgrimage - March 28th, 2024

The Tradition

After Mass on Holy Thursday, the Blessed Sacrament is placed on an Altar of Repose for Adoration by the faithful. The faithful are encouraged to visit seven churches and adore the Lord in the Eucharist (this tradition is typically credited to St. Philip Neri). There is something powerful about making a late-night pilgrimage to our Eucharistic Lord.

To Guide Your Prayer

- 1. Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane (Luke 22:39-46)
- 2. Jesus Bound and Taken Before Annas (John 18:19-22)
- 3. Jesus Taken Before the High Priest, Caiaphas (Matthew 26:63-65)
- 4. Jesus Taken Before Pilate (John 18:35-37)
- 5. Jesus Taken Before Herod (Luke 23:8-9; 11)
- 6. Jesus Taken Before Pilate Again (Matthew 27:22-26)
- 7. Jesus Given the Crown of Thorns and Led to His Crucifixion (Matthew 27:27-31)

Each church corresponds with one of the seven "stops" made by Jesus on His way to Calvary.

The Journey

St. Joseph, Wapakoneta; Immaculate Conception, Botkins; Holy Angels, Sidney; Sacred Heart, McCartyville; St. Augustine, Minster; Holy Redeemer, New Bremen; Holy Rosary, St. Mary's. Begin your self-led pilgrimage at any of these churches after their Holy Thursday Mass has ended (all Masses are at 7pm, except Holy Redeemer which is at 7:30pm). All churches will be open for Adoration through the evening and close at midnight, with the exception of Holy Angels and Sacred Heart, which will remain open for Adoration all through the night. Adoration at Sacred Heart will take place in the St. Philomena Chapel. Adoration at Holy Rosary will take place in the Chapel of the Sacred Heart. St. Pope John Paul II declared the Sunday after Easter Divine Mercy Sunday and in order that the faithful would observe this day with intense devotion, enriched it with an indulgence.

He will never ask for iTunes gift cards or send messages like this. If you're ever questioning a text or email, please call the parish office before responding. If you've been scammed, ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.






