

Pastoral Council Transitions

ver the past couple of years, our Pastoral Council has remained largely the same. This was to help us get through the parish merger. The members of the Pastoral Council have generously served for years to provide stability in the midst of the transition. I am incredibly grateful for their time and honesty over the past couple of years.

As we anticipate the parish merger in July, many of the members of the Pastoral Council will be stepping down. Some will remain so that it isn't an entirely new group.

We'll return to the process of years past. At this point, we are seeking nominations for the Pastoral Council. There are openings for each of our four parishes. If you feel that God is calling you to serve our parishes in this way, please contact me. You can send me an email at fr:wilson@petersburgparishes.org or call the office at 419-738-2115. We'll be accepting nominations until Sunday, April 7.

Once the nomination process is over, we'll have short biographies of our nominees in the bulletin. In the middle of May, at Sunday Mass, we'll vote for new Pastoral Council members. The newly-elected Pastoral Council members will officially assume their three-year term on July 1, 2024.

Pastoral Council serves an important role for our parishes. They are the official group of advisors for the pastor. They provide a listening ear to parishioners and communicate the thoughts of parishioners to the pastor. They offer feedback on different parish initiatives and

constructive criticism on various issues.

The Pastoral Council is a consultative group, not a deliberative body. This means that they offer advice - they are not decision-makers. This is a common misunderstanding and even one that I have failed to realize. We shouldn't say, "Pastoral Council decided." Rather we say, "Pastoral Council recommended."

In the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, there are certain matters about which the Pastoral Council must be consulted, such as expenditures over \$25,000.

So what are the qualities we are looking for in new Pastoral Council members? At the bare minimum, they must be 19 years old and have received all the Sacraments of Initiation. Also, they should regularly practice the Catholic faith. They must be open to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. Finally, they must be able to speak with parishioners about parish matters.

The role of Pastoral Council is to seek God's will for our parish. The pastor isn't a Lone Ranger, but he asks this council where God is guiding us. Where is the Lord leading?

Please prayerfully consider being part of Pastoral Council. Also, please pray about who may be a great fit on the Pastoral Council and speak with him or her about it. Again, if you believe that the Lord is leading you in this direction, please contact me.

Holy Thursday Pilgrimage - March 28th, 2024

The Tradition

After Mass on Holy Thursday, the Blessed Sacrament is placed on an Altar of Repose for Adoration by the faithful. The faithful are encouraged to visit seven churches and adore the Lord in the Eucharist (this tradition is typically credited to St. Philip Neri). There is something powerful about making a late-night pilgrimage to our Eucharistic Lord.

To Guide Your Prayer

- 1. Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane (Luke 22:39-46)
- 2. Jesus Bound and Taken Before Annas (John 18:19-22)
- 3. Jesus Taken Before the High Priest, Caiaphas (Matthew 26:63-65)
- 4. Jesus Taken Before Pilate (John 18:35-37)
- 5. Jesus Taken Before Herod (Luke 23:8-9; 11)
- 6. Jesus Taken Before Pilate Again (Matthew 27:22-26)
- 7. Jesus Given the Crown of Thorns and Led to His Crucifixion (Matthew 27:27-31)

Each church corresponds with one of the seven "stops" made by Jesus on His way to Calvary.

The Journey

St. Joseph, Wapakoneta; Immaculate Conception, Botkins; Holy Angels, Sidney; Sacred Heart, McCartyville; St. Augustine, Minster; Holy Redeemer, New Bremen; Holy Rosary, St. Mary's. Begin your self-led pilgrimage at any of these churches after their Holy Thursday Mass has ended (all Masses are at 7pm, except Holy Redeemer which is at 7:30pm). If you've been scammed, ignore the message (or report it as a "phishing message") and say a prayer for the scammer.




